

General Pest Control Program

Our Approach

In order to reduce environmental impact, we believe less is more when it comes to insect control. We practice Integrated Pest Management (IPM) and as such we do not encourage quarterly treatments. Our service includes a bi-annual treatment using quality products that will control most nuisance insects. Reduced applications mean less pollution and promote a healthy environment for you and your loved ones.



Boundary Treatments

We apply a residual granular insecticide to your lawn and landscape for crawling insects.

Exterior Perimeter Treatments

A premium residual insecticide is applied concentrating on the entry points for insects into your home.

Interior Treatments

Interior areas are inspected and treated on an as needed basis for the pests present in your home. A combination of residual insecticides, baits and traps may be used based on your concerns and particular pests.

Helpful Tips

You can help reduce pests by eliminating harborage areas on the exterior. For example, keep trees and shrubs trimmed away from the house, pick up leaves and lawn debris, keep wood piles and stored items away from the house, use minimal exterior lighting and/or use bug lights, keep pet food and bird seed picked up and store in sealed containers. Inside, keep sugary products in plastic bags or containers, do not leave pet food out at night, wipe cooking areas and prevent grease build up. These helpful tips will go a long way in reducing pest populations and help you get the most from our service.

Other Information

Our general service will control most common nuisance insects. However, specialty treatments are not covered and may require an additional service. These include but are not limited to: Fleas/ticks, structural ants, wood destroying pests, German cockroaches, flying insects, vermin or other non-insect pests.
